
Information for Authors

1. Submission Requirements

- Articles must demonstrate a high degree of scholarship. They will be screened by the editorial board and undergo double-blind peer review.
- Submissions may be written in English or Filipino. For articles written in Filipino, the following must be provided in English translation:
 - Title
 - Abstract (not exceeding 300 words)
 - Five (5) keywords
- Articles in Filipino that translate quoted materials in English must provide the original text.
- Reviews of books, exhibits, websites, films, fora, and other relevant events are also accepted. Reviews should:
 - Provide a critical assessment of the work's arguments, methodology, and contribution, rather than a summary
 - Be approximately 1,500 words, written in English or Filipino, with no abstract required
 - Include complete bibliographic information for the work under discussion
 - Be subject to editorial review; double-blind peer review does not apply
- Submissions should be accompanied by approximately five lines of author biodata, including the author's present position and area of work, e-mail address (institutional e-mails preferred), institutional affiliation(s), and country. Individuals who contributed to the conceptualization of the paper may be acknowledged in the Acknowledgments section.
- Funding sources, if any, should be indicated; write *none* if there are no funding sources.
- All submissions must be made via SALIKSIK, the University of the Philippines Diliman's centralized submission and repository platform (<https://saliksik.upd.edu.ph/>), accessible using a Gmail account. The Humanities Diliman journal page is available at <https://saliksik.upd.edu.ph/journal-issue/HD>.

2. Article Length

- Research articles should range from 5,000 to 12,000 words.
- Reviews should be approximately 1,500 words.

3. Citation Style

- *Humanities Diliman* follows the **MLA style (9th edition, 2021)**. Please refer to: https://owl.purdue.edu/owl/research_and_citation/mla_style/mla_formatting_and_style_guide/mla_general_format.html
- Only manuscripts formatted according to MLA will be considered for review.
- Please use in-text citations and provide a Works Cited list. Endnotes should be limited to explanatory notes.
- Non-English sources must be accompanied by English translations.

4. Manuscript Format

- Manuscripts must be electronically prepared, double-spaced, with 1" margin on all sides.
- Accepted file types: **rtf, doc, docx**.

5. File Naming Format

- To facilitate the processing of submissions, please name all files using the following format: Surname_TITLE NAME_File Type

- Please use the same title across all submission files.

6. Double-Blind Peer Review and File Upload Requirements

- Manuscripts must be prepared for **double-anonymized peer review**.
- The Main Document must not contain any identifying information, including author names, affiliations, acknowledgments, ORCID iDs, funding information, self-identifying references, or other details that may reveal the identity of the author(s).
- Upload the following files separately through the submission platform:
 1. **Main Document** – anonymized manuscript, including figures, tables, and captions
 2. **Title Page** – author details
 3. **Bio Note** – 2–3 sentences per author
 4. **Figures** – anonymized, at least 300 dpi (if applicable)
 5. **Acknowledgments** – submitted as a separate file, if applicable
- Authors are responsible for securing permission to reproduce copyrighted materials.
